
Advanced Registered Nurse Practitioners (ARNPs)

The advanced registered nurse practitioner (ARNP) license category in Washington includes:

- Certified registered nurse anesthetists (CRNAs).
- Certified nurse midwives (CNMs).
- Nurse practitioners (NPs).
- Clinical nurse specialists (CNSs).

In Washington State, ARNPs must also hold active registered nurse licenses. The following Washington statistics were calculated based on data from the ARNP license files, which contain licensee name, mailing address, birthdate, and gender.








ARNP Age and Gender

Washington State ARNP data are from the Washington State Department of Health, Health Professions Licensing Data System, 2016 (April), 2014 (April), 2013 (April), 2011 (March), 2008 (September), 2007 (October), 2006 (August), 2004, and 1999. All analyses include ARNPs ages 18 through 75.

General Washington population data are from the Washington State Office of Financial Management and are updated April 1 of each year (http://www.ofm.wa.gov/pop/april1/).

The urban-rural location of each ARNP was determined using their license ZIP code and the Rural-Urban Commuting Area Codes 3.1.
