## Online Appendix - Unweighted Response Counts and Percentages for Each Survey Question

Advanced Registered Nurse Practitioners (ARNPs) in Washington State were required to complete an online survey with questions about their demographics, work characteristics and education history. ARNPs are certified as Nurse Practitioners (NPs), Certified Registered Nurse Anesthetists (CRNAs), Certified Nurse Midwives (CNMs) or Clinical Nurse Specialists (CNSs).

The tables below show unweighted responses for each certification level, meaning they show the number of ARNPs who selected each response option for each question in the Nursys survey. These should not be confused with the weighted estimates presented in the Full Report at https://depts.washington.edu/fammed/chws/wp-content/uploads/sites/5/2020/04/WA_ARNP_Survey_2019.pdf See Appendix A of the full report for a more complete description of the weighting process.

## Notes:

1) Sex, age and mailing address were collected for all ARNPs when they initiated or renewed their nursing license. See Appendix A for information about these variables.
2) Number of employment positions, number of hours worked, employment setting, employment specialty, position title(s) and employment ZIP Code questions were only asked of ARNPs who indicated they were employed in nursing. All other questions were asked of all ARNPs taking the survey.
3) Table cells with responses from less than 10 nurses were suppressed to protect the identity of nurses and to indicate that these estimates may be unreliable due to the small number of survey responses. Some additional cells with 10 or more responses were also suppressed to prevent back-calculation of the cells with fewer than 10 responses.
