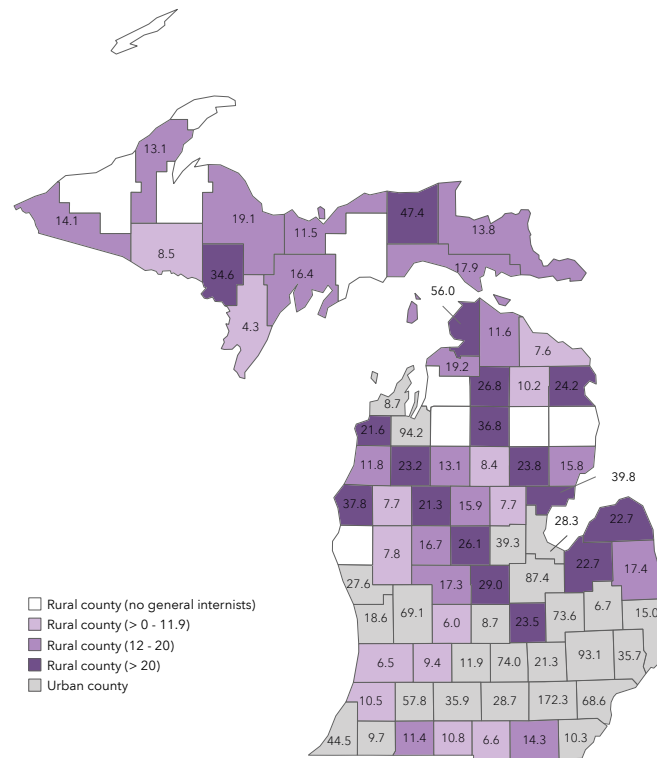

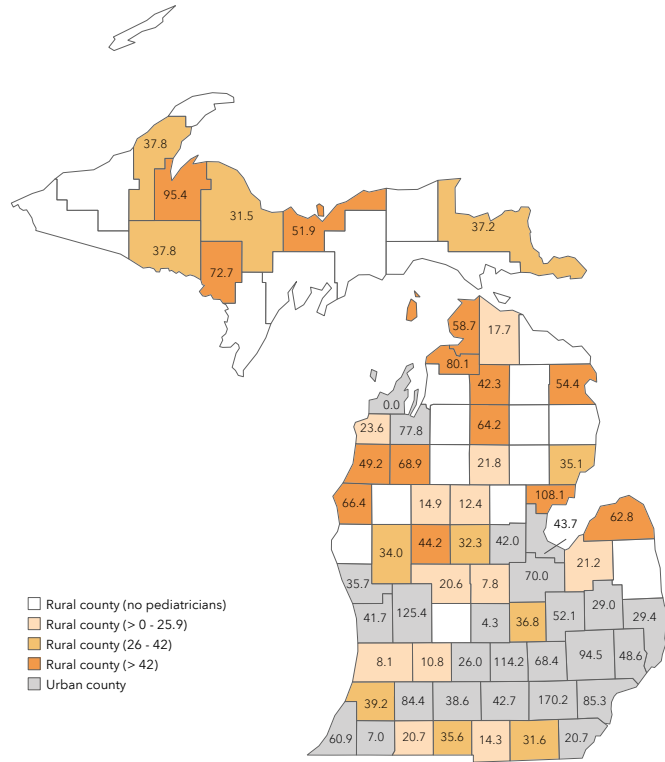

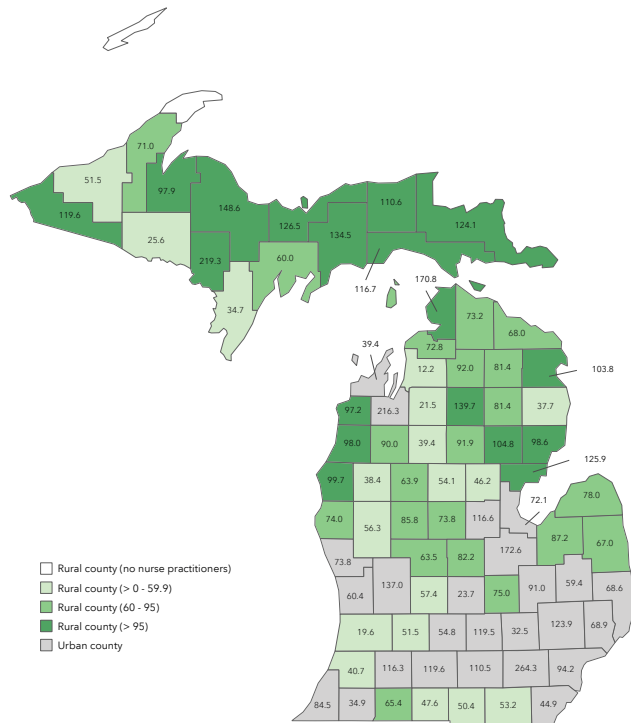
Figure 3. General Pediatricians per 100,000 Youth* Population in Michigan Rural Counties, 2025
