IMMC is a physician owned group practice of about 7 family physicians. Dr. Zachary Warnock is the unit clerkship coordinator and will coordinate your activities and schedule. You will spend time with Dr. Warnock and several others in the practice (Drs. Andy Thayne, Brandon Mickelsen, Travis Nielsen, Blaine Olsen, and Scott Christensen. Most of our physicians are also involved in teaching at the Idaho State University Family Medicine Residency.

You will have opportunity to participate in the diversity of family medicine with multiple different physicians in the practice, including regularly scheduled clinic and an onsite urgent care staffed by the providers. You will also be able to participate in and choose from other learning experiences including hospital admissions, nursing home visits, home health and hospice visits in the patient's home, a free clinic that serves uninsured and under-insured patients, a juvenile detention center, and a women's prison. Students can also expect to spend a half day during the six week clerkship with a physical therapist and an orthopedic surgeon. You may also have the chance to participate in obstetrical care in the clinic and OB call at the local hospital. We can usually accommodate other particular wishes and interests as well. Family medicine is diverse and versatile and we hope to provide you with that experience.

The Pocatello medical community has an active series of didactic sessions. Students usually spend one day a week at the Pocatello Family Medicine Residency, often in didactic teaching sessions or working with physicians in one of the outreach clinics offered (ie HIV, Women's Prison, Juvenile Detention). There is one hospital, Portneuf Medical Center, a new state-of-the-art facility where students can participate in admissions in the emergency room and rounding with the inpatient team.

located across the street from InterMountain Medical Clinic. Pocatello is within a few hours of the Grand Tetons, Yellowstone Park, Sun Valley, Jackson Hole and Salt Lake City's ski resorts. Any of these locations would be a great weekend getaway during your clerkship with us. Pebble Creek Ski Resort is a 15 minute drive. Fantastic hiking and mountain biking trails surround the valley.

Duties

Students will be expected to participate actively in the care of the patients and should work to seek out continuity of care opportunities. Your independence in the clinic and other activities will evolve over the course of the rotation to expand your abilities. You will be expected to select two (or more if desired) evening urgent care shifts to participate in. Have a great time learning from the many different styles of practice amongst our providers. Family practitioners in the group have developed special practice emphases including diabetes, female medicine, obstetrics, pediatrics, osteoporosis, geriatrics, hospice, and faculty development.

Housing

You can stay in our newer, two bedroom, two bathroom townhouse that includes a garage, patio and all the amenities. Washer and dryer, central vacuum, cable TV and high speed wireless internet, dishwasher, full size stove, refrigerator and microwave, children's playground and outside basketball court. The house is furnished; new living room furniture, bedding, cookware, dishes, towels, sheets, and ironing board. Arrangements for spouse or family can be made with the site coordinator and other student sharing the rotation (if applicable). The apartment is located within three miles of the clinic, four miles of the hospital and close to shopping and restaurants. No pets please. Car required.
