## *Not graduating quite yet?*

Here are a few reminders to keep you on track to graduate with the UP!

Clinical Phases: 1) Remember to keep in touch with your mentor every quarter until you graduate! 2) [Check out the list of web modules](#) to see if there's anything that will help you on your upcoming rotations. 3) To include the pathway in your MSPE, the deadline for completing roughly 70% of the UP requirements is July 31st of the year you need your MSPE. Foundations: 1) Keep an eye out to identify your UP mentor. Remember that all students must be matched with a mentor by the end of the Life Cycle & Reproduction Block. Let us know if you need any help or when you do find someone to be your UP mentor. 2) Be sure to [get started on a few web modules](#). Many students say they wish they'd started on the modules sooner because of how applicable they were during their clinical experiences. 3) If you will not or did not do RUOP or GHIP, you'll need to do an underserved-focus Scholarly Project to fulfill the UP requirement.
