FAMILY MEDICINE SUB-INTERNSHIP Grading Criteria 2023-24

Grading Criteria

1. Honors

Students must receive at least eight scores of 5 and no score less than a 4 in any category for Honors. A Honors grade reflects the performance of a student operating above the level expected for a fourth year student (Explore & Focus Phase).

2. High Pass

Students must receive at least eight scores of 4 and no score less than a 3 in any category for High Pass. A High Pass grade reflects the performance of a student at the expected level for a fourth year student (Explore & Focus Phase).

3. Pass

The Pass grade reflects the performance of a student at the expected level for a third year clerkship student (Patient Care Phase).

4. Fail

A failing grade is based on student's performance taken as a whole and not solely based on any one numeric profile. A 1 in any category will result in a failure. Multiple 2's may result in a failure.

Overall Assessment of Professionalism

Assessment of student professionalism is based on the "Interpersonal Relationships" and "Personal Characteristics" categories of the evaluation form.

- 1. Meets or Exceeds Expectations: 3 or above in ALL categories
- 2. **Below Expectations**: 2 in any category
- 3. Unacceptable: 1 in any category
